



Dual Degree Program Agreement

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (Yunlin, Taiwan)

This Master's Dual Degree Program Agreement is between Partner University (hereinafter "abbreviation for school name") and National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (hereinafter "YunTech"). Appendices may be added upon mutual consent.

I. Rationale

The purpose of this agreement is to offer students the opportunities for studying abroad, cooperation promotion and development of both parties, including increased language ability, professional work, and research experiences.

II. Degree Conferral

Upon completing the Dual Degree Program, participants who meet each respective institution's graduation requirements will be conferred a Master's degree from YunTech and a Master's degree from Partner University.

Matters concerning a student's participation in the Dual Degree Program, including thesis submission, registration, and degree examinations, shall be handled in accordance with the regulations mutually recognized by both institutions. The guiding principle of the Dual Degree Program is for students to obtain degrees conferred by both institutions. For students nominated by YunTech to participate in this program, should they fail to obtain the degree from YunTech, the nominating unit must revoke their dual degree status through a specialized review process. Furthermore, the recognition of any degree conferred by the foreign university shall be conducted in accordance with the "Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Records by Universities" promulgated by the Ministry of Education.

III. Eligibility, Selection Process and Quotas

- a. The students enrolled in [Partner University](#) at YunTech are eligible to apply for this program.
- b. [Partner University](#) will be responsible for selecting participating students to be considered for admission to YunTech under this Dual Degree Program. YunTech shall make the final admission decisions based on the same requirements as those for regular international student applications.
- c. The applicants will be evaluated by YunTech on their application documents and supporting materials based on the process and requirements specified by the Graduate School at YunTech. Specific admission criteria, including required application documents and language proficiency thresholds, are detailed in Appendix A of this Agreement.

IV. Length of Study

The participants shall study at least [Number](#) semesters at YunTech and at least [Number](#) semesters at [Partner University](#).

V. Articulated Curriculum, Credit Transfer and Acceptance

The students must meet the graduation credit requirements of both universities. They must take at least [Number](#) credits of courses at [Partner University](#) and at least [Number](#) credits of courses at YunTech, along with any other YunTech program requirements as published from time to time. The students must also complete a thesis to be granted a Master's degree at YunTech. The Articulated Curriculum is specified in the Articulation Agreement entered into between the parties.

VI. Enrollment, Registration, Suspension, Resumption and Grading

- a. The process of enrollment, registration for courses, temporary suspension, resumption, and grading shall conform to the academic policies of both universities. Participants have to register at YunTech in the last semester.
- b. YunTech is responsible for advising students in course registration when the participants study at YunTech.
- c. Both parties ultimately determine whether the courses the participants take at the other institution will be recognized by the other.

VII. Tuition and Fees

For enrollment, grade evaluations, scholarships, student services, student code of conduct, advising, and other related matters, the applicable regulations for each university shall be observed. Enrolled students are eligible for applying the financial assistance provided by YunTech as below:

YunTech provides qualified students one of the following financial assistances based on each applying student's academic performance. The financial assistance period is up to 1 year for students participating in the program.

- Full scholarship: full tuition waive plus up to NTS 10,000 scholarship per month.
- Partial scholarship: full tuition waive plus up to NTS 6,000 scholarship per month.
- Tuition waive: waiver for full tuition, waiver for half tuition, and waiver for a quarter of the tuition.

VIII. Health Certificate and Insurance

Participants must meet the health and insurance requirements as set forth for international students.

IX. Compliance with Laws

The parties will comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations.

X. Summary of the Agreement (Credit Allocation)

- a. Academic personnel from both parties have evaluated the curriculum and determined there are enough similarities to merit a formal articulation agreement.
- b. YunTech students must take at least [Number](#) credits of courses and complete a thesis to be granted a Master's degree.
- c. [Partner University](#) students must take at least [Number](#) credits of courses to be granted a Master's degree. (Note: Adjust the credit numbers above based on the specific department curriculum)

XII. Rights & Responsibilities

- a. Both Parties are accredited institutions of higher education in their respective countries. The Parties agree to notify the other in writing if any material change to their accreditation status occurs.
- b. Both parties agree to inform the other of curricular and policy changes on an annual

basis to ensure currency with the parties' respective degree requirements.

- c. Separate academic records will be maintained at each party. The parties acknowledge that all participating student records arising pursuant to this Agreement are confidential. Each party agrees that disclosure of such information will be made only in compliance with applicable privacy laws (e.g., FERPA for US institutions).

XIII. Maintenance of the Agreement

This Agreement will be effective for a period of five years from the date of final signature and shall expire five years thereafter, unless the parties agree in writing to extend this Agreement. The Dean of College of Management at YunTech and the [Partner University Official](#) shall review and update the Agreement annually.

XIV. Miscellaneous

- a. Anti-Corruption Clause: The parties agree that each is familiar with applicable laws prohibiting corruption and bribery (such as the U.S. Foreign Corrupt Practices Act). Any breach shall be deemed a breach of this Agreement.
- b. Entire Agreement: This Agreement contains the entire understanding and agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior written or oral agreements.
- c. Language: For ease of reference, the parties agree to translate this agreement into Mandarin and execute the same. To the extent there is any conflict between the English and Mandarin versions, the English version shall control.

XV. Effectiveness, Modification and Termination

This Agreement shall take effect on the date of the final signature. If either institution intends to terminate or modify this Agreement, a written notice should be given to the other institution six months before the desired effective date. Such termination will not adversely affect any students currently enrolled at any stage of the Program.

Appendix A: Admission Requirements and Application Documents

This appendix outlines the specific admission requirements for Partner University students applying to the Dual Degree Program at YunTech. These requirements are subject to periodic updates by YunTech.

1. Language Proficiency Requirement: Applicants must meet the minimum English proficiency requirements as specified below:

- TOEFL iBT: Minimum score of [e.g., 79]
- IELTS: Minimum score of [e.g., 6.5]
