Teaching Objectives

For students nowadays, it is not big deals speaking English and writing an article or paragraph in English; however, knowing how to use critical thinking in daily conversation, and knowing how to write a reasonable paragraph are another story. In this course, students will be instructed how to use logic, coherence, and diversification in both question-answering and article-writing session in TOEIC Test. The students in this courses are required to reach the B2 level of CEFR; therefore, all the teaching materials, syllabus and teaching strategies will be relevant to TOEIC speaking and writing Test. Quick questions answering, situated questions responding, picture description, academic writing, letter and email writing, and diagram writing will be lectured in the following 14 weeks. In a consequence, the final objectives of the course will guide all the students having no problems in the Test for Speaking and Writing and pass the level of B2.
